WCS Board Presentation June 2021
Subject: Update on Ohio Senate Bill 210

1. Limit access to unhealthy foods and beverages in schools
2. Increase daily physical activity
3. Implement body mass index screenings
4. Develop and implement a school health measure on district and building grade cards.

This bill covers the whole school day and extended school day.

It defines food and beverage standards of food and beverages that are sold students in all areas of the school. It does not apply to sporting events or fundraisers after the school day. **Fundraisers that are done during the school day must follow the guidelines.**

These standards apply to **ALL** food and beverage **SOLD** to students, during the school day and extended day and **INCLUDES** vending.

This does not affect fundraisers or sporting events concessions, but does require the nutrition standards apply to all food sold during the school day.

All ala-carte (extra food) sold in the cafeteria meets the Smart Snack and SB 210 guidelines.

To my knowledge all schools met the requirements also.
